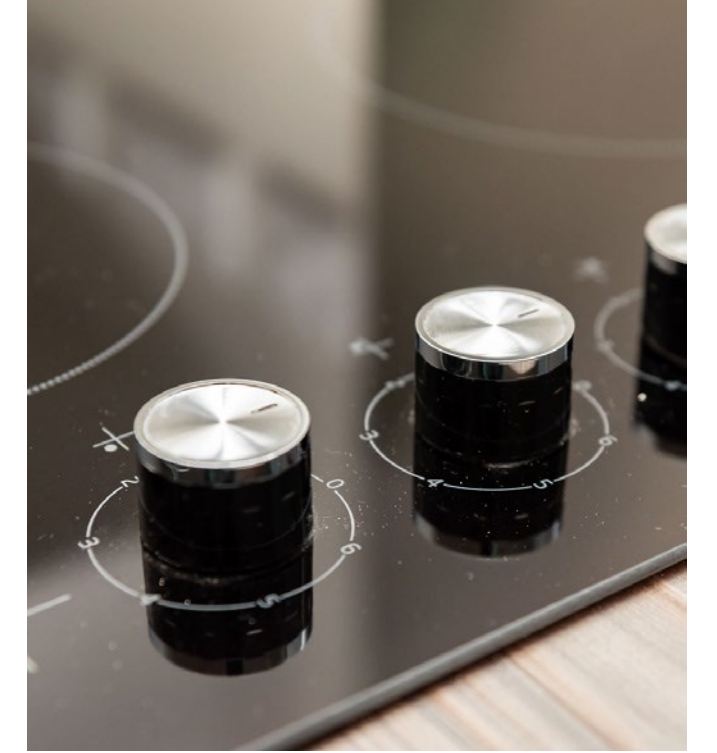

The Location

Having been recognised as part of her late Majesty the Queen's Platinum Jubilee celebrations, Doncaster is revelling in its new status as one of England's newest cities. Situated within the south of the UK's largest county, Yorkshire, and home to over 100,000 residents, Doncaster nestles nearby the River Don and between Sheffield and Hull.

At the heart of the city is a historical market town where Regency buildings, Norman castles along with rich railway and horse racing legacy thrive.

Connectivity

Doncaster is well-connected to the rest of the UK and Europe thanks to its good road systems and airports close by. The city is located on the M18 motorway, which connects it to Leeds, Sheffield, and the Humber ports. Doncaster Sheffield Airport is also located just outside the city, and offers flights to destinations across the UK, Europe, and the Middle East.

Doncaster Racecourse is a Group 1 racecourse and it is one of the oldest racecourses in Britain, having been founded in 1560. The racecourse is home to two of Great Britain's 36 annual Group 1 flat races, the St Leger Stakes and the Racing Post Trophy.
